Good Morning,

It's that time of year again and I would like to give you advance notice that I will be placing our poppy wreath order on **Thursday 1st August 2024**.

Therefore, please could I ask that you let me have your order by **31st July 2024 at the latest**.

Type E Wreath - Chaplet

The Type E wreath (oval chaplet) has now been discontinued and is no longer available. A range of available wreaths is shown below.

Most wreaths laid at the memorial are a Type B (open centre) or Type C (with or without centre badge).

Please note that the Type C wreath with an organisational badge in the centre is **£27.50**.

Payment of Wreaths

We kindly ask that all payments are received on the collection / delivery of your

wreath.

Payment can be made by **cash, cheque** or where the local Poppy Appeal Organiser has a contactless terminal, by **card**.

Note: I should have a contactless terminal from mid-July until the end of August, and then again from late September if you prefer to pay this way.

I will send further details regarding payment once I receive the wreaths.

I anticipate the wreaths will be ready for collection / delivery from mid September onwards, and I will email again once I am in receipt of the them.

Action Required

Please could you advise me of the following details by return email, no later than **31st July 2023** if possible:

- If you would like me to order a wreath(s) for you in 2024, (I will order the same as last year unless advised differently).
- If you would like me to order a wreath, but will be unable to advise me by 31st July 2024..
- Alternatively, please let me know if you do not wish to receive a poppy wreath this year.

If you think you may have difficulty notifying me by the 31st July, please let me know and I will do all I can to assist.

Order of Service

For those laying a wreath on Remembrance Sunday at Great Dunmow War Memorial an Order of Service (including the wreath laying order), will be emailed nearer the time, once everything has been confirmed.

If you have any questions on the above, please don't hesitate to get in touch.

And Finally...

If you, or anyone you know would be interested in becoming a Poppy Appeal volunteer, or would like to find out more, please let me know.

No experience is necessary, it would just be giving up 1 or 2 hours of your time during the Poppy Appeal (late Oct - Early Nov), to help man our Poppy stall at Great Dunmow Tesco or Co-op. We particularly need people who could help out on weekdays. There is a rota, so you can pick a time to suit, generally between 9 - 6pm.
